In the last quarter of the year 2011, WARSHE started the ground work for the study of the incidence of sexual violence and abuse (SVA) against girls in high schools and young women in tertiary institutions in Oyo and Osun states. We undertook field work in January, February and May 2012; and we have concluded analyses of data and report writing.

- The consequences of the abuse they had suffered
- Respondents' reaction to their abuse
- How significant persons handled the sexual abuse of our respondents
- Why they were abused/the circumstances that made them prone to abuse, and
- Our recommendations
